Lesson one:

Four images of their work each plus information on their style, nationality, influences and how they link to Day of the Dead.

Present both creatively and compare and contrast their work using art terms.



Lesson two:

Explore repeat pattern, what does this mean, get three examples, add in images of block printing where they have used creative shapes linking to Mexican fabric designs.

Lesson three:

Research the history and origins of Batik, present this creatively, also create a double page spread on images related to sugar skulls these will help your cushion design.

Lesson four:

Design a repeat pattern using ideas from Day of the Dead and Mexican patterns

Lesson five:

Create a leaflet with images and information on modern printing techniques.

Ensure you have looked at eco-friendly printing also.

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Lesson six:


Students to research and plan how they could use embellishments on their cushion. Get images of at least three embellishments and present these with sketches of your cushion and where they could be used.



Lesson seven:

Create a textiles grid showing images and information on decorations used in textiles. Investigate at least 5.
